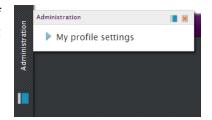
How to Change Your webCampus Profile Settings

The **Profile** displays basic information about a user along with a profile picture. Site-wide preferences are also customized in the Profile.

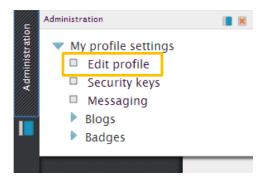
Locate the Administration block (formerly the Settings block)



* If the block is not in the right-hand column of the course/site home page, remember to check the margin tabs to see if the block is docked (as in the image on the right).



Click My profile settings to open the menu and click Edit profile.



Determine your Profile preferences. (See below for tips on setting your Profile preferences)



Tips for setting your Profile preferences:

Email digest type: determines how frequently you receive email posts from forums you are subscribed.

• No digest (single email per forum post) means that you will receive an email every time someone posts or replies to a post in your subscribed forum(s) with the complete post content. This can result in a large amount of email if you are in multiple courses with multiple forums.

How to Change Your webCampus Profile Settings

- Complete (daily email with full posts) means that you will receive one "digest" e-mail per day (at 5 pm) containing the complete contents of each forum post from your subscribed forum(s). Each post will also have a link back to its originating forum in webCampus.
- Subjects (daily email with subjects only) means that you will receive one "digest" e-mail per day containing just the subject of each forum post from your subscribed forum(s) and a link back to the forum.

Forum Tracking: Choosing *yes* for this feature will highlight new posts for you. We recommend this be set to *yes*.

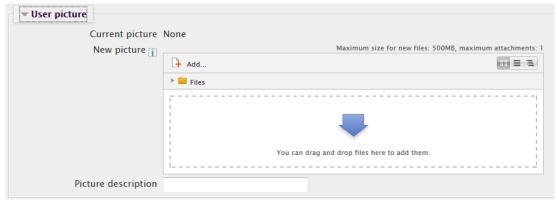

Description: Use the *Description* field to enter text about yourself.

This box enables you to enter some text about yourself which will then be displayed on your profile page for others to view.

User Picture: We encourage everyone to add a picture in their profile. To add a User picture:

1. Click on the *User picture* title to expand the block



2. Drag and drop your photo into the field indicated by the blue arrow. In the *Picture description* field you can enter your name.

Interests: You have the option of sharing more about your interests with your classmates.

- 1. To add your interests, click on the *Interests* title to expand the block.
- 2. Type your personal or professional interests in the text box separating each subject with a comma.



3. Your interests will be displayed on your Profile page as tags.

Finally, scroll down the page and click the *Update profile* button to save your preferences.
